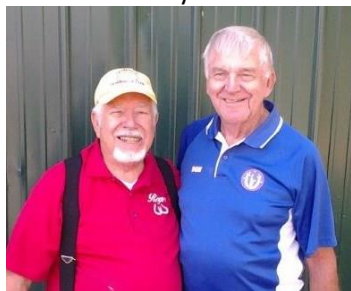

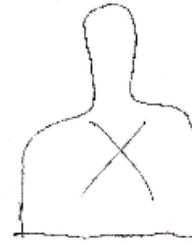

Sportsman of the Year: voting will be during the charter meeting. This year you may **NOT** vote for James Sizemore, Grady Coleman, and Buster Williams. The winner will have their 2018 Sanction card paid for and receive a plaque.

2017 Rookie of the Year: will be announced in the meeting. The winner will receive a plaque and have the 2018 sanction card paid for.

NHPA/TNHPA rules correction: The non- handicap third tie breaker for below 1st place will be changed to the greatest over or closest to entering ringer percentage instead of total points scored as was voted for in 2013. NHPA rule 11 section B #2 does not allow that tie breaker. It was a TNHPA error for allowing this change in 2013. This will be in sync with HS Master program and NHPA. This change is in effect immediately.

PROPOSAL FOR VOTE: There has been negative feedback on the Current Tournament Fee and Prize List therefore I am proposing that we return to the \$20 Tournament Fee along with the attached proposed prize payout for 2018. (Doug Farnsworth) Payout #1 option

The \$20 Tournament Fee would be broke down as follows;

- \$3 State Tournament
- \$1 TNHPA
- \$1 Local Horseshoe Courts
- \$1 Tournament Director
- \$14 Prize payout
